June 16 Meeting rescheduled to June 17 due to technical issues.

1. Approved the resignation of Pamela Nordstrom for retirement purposes, with regret and appreciation, from her position as an Art Teacher assigned to the high school effective the close of business on June 30, 2020. Ms. Nordstrom has been employed by the district since October 1993.
2. Approved the probationary appointment of Patrick Cullinan to the Administrative Tenure Area of School Principal July 1, 2020 initially assigned to the Middle School.
3. Approved the resignation(s) of Laura Smith From her position as an elementary teacher assigned to Union East effective June 30, 2020.

4. Approved to abolish the following effective June 30, 2020 or as listed:
 - Two (2) Professional Education Positions In The Special Subject Tenure Area Of Education of Children with handicapping conditions—General Special Education
 - Two (2) Professional Education Position In The Academic Tenure Area Of Mathematics (one due to a retirement)
 - One Professional Education Positions In The Special Subject Tenure Area Of Industrial Arts - general
 - One Professional Education Positions In The Special Subject Tenure Area Of School Counselor
 - One Professional Education Positions In The Elementary Tenure Area
 - One Professional Education Position In The Special Subject Tenure Area Of Art
 - One Certified Occupational Therapy Assistant (COTA)
 - One full-time Custodian
 - One Teacher Aide (due to retirement) - effective June 25, 2020
5. Approved the creation of one 1.0 Occupational Therapist Registered (OTR) to service the district.
6. Approved to lay off eleven (11) full-time employees serving in the title of Teacher Aide, and one Microcomputer Repair Technician effective at the close of business on June 25, 2020.
7. Approved the Discontinuance of two (2) Probationary Appointment(s) in the special subject tenure area of School Counselor effective at the close of business on June 30, 2020.
8. Approved the placement of students as indicated on his/her Individual Education Plan (I.E.P.) and as listed in the attached CPSE, CSE and/or Sub CSE minutes as well as all other recommended changes and annual reviews as listed in the minutes.
9. Approved to delegate the Board's authority to hire teachers, teaching assistants and teacher aides to the Superintendent through September 30, 2020.
10. Approved for attendance and payment (of expenses also) for the Board of Education and/or Superintendent at conferences, seminars, meetings and institutes sponsored by the following organizations during the 2020-21 school year: National School Board Association; NYS School Boards Association; Erie County Association of School Boards; American Association of School Administrators; Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development, NYS Council of School Superintendents, including the Erie-Niagara Superintendents Association and the WNY Educational Service Council
11. Approved the Tribe Track & Field Summer Track Club's request the use of the outdoor track on days cleared by the Athletic Director from June 22 - August 1, 2020, 5:00 pm - 6:30 pm, following the health guidelines due to the COVID-19 health crisis.
12. Received and filed the Treasurer's Report for the months of 12/19, 1/20, 2/20, 3/20.

13. Held the Public Hearing on the proposed amendments to the Code of Conduct for 2020-21. It is anticipated that the Board will adopt the 2020-21 Code of Conduct at its meeting on July 7, 2020.
14. Reviewed the draft of the July 7, 2020 organization meeting agenda along with policies 1330 and 1620 which outline the order of business are provided.
15. Reviewed the current Board goals in preparation for the development of the 2020-21 goals which are anticipated to be finalized and acted on at the July 7 Board Meeting.
16. Reviewed the Residency Report and/or a summary of permission granted to remain in the district (senior privilege, etc.).
17. Approved the following contract(s) with terms as stated in agreement/proposal:
