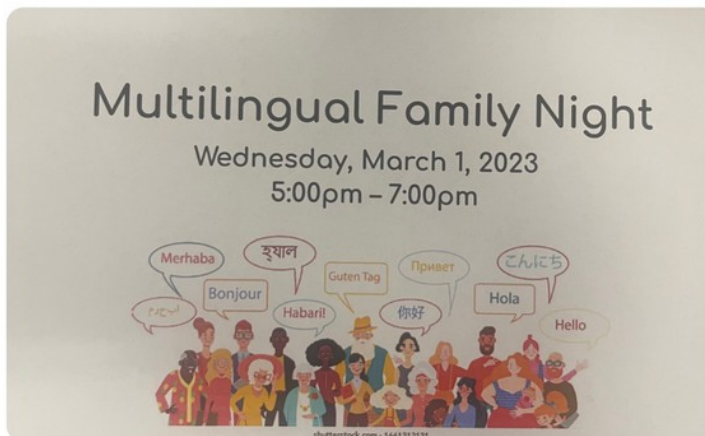

## Scurry Along...

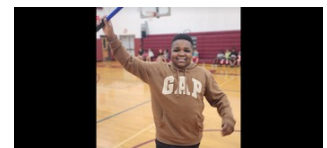
In Miss Barbati's and Mr. Haberl's Physical Education classes students played a lead up game to floor hockey called scurry hockey.

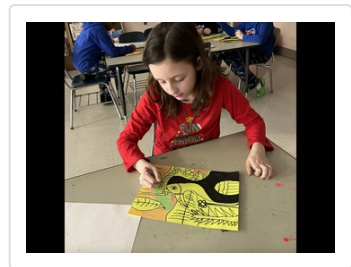
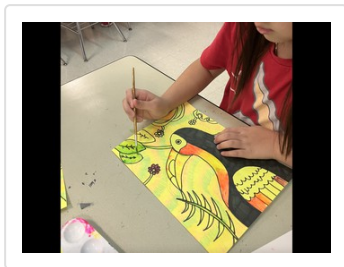
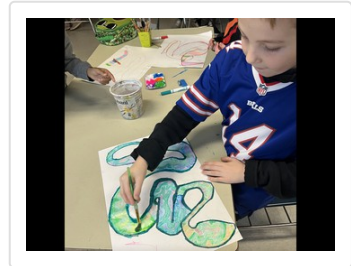
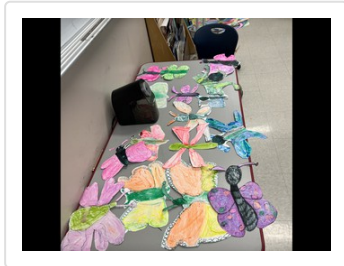


George of the Jungle...
