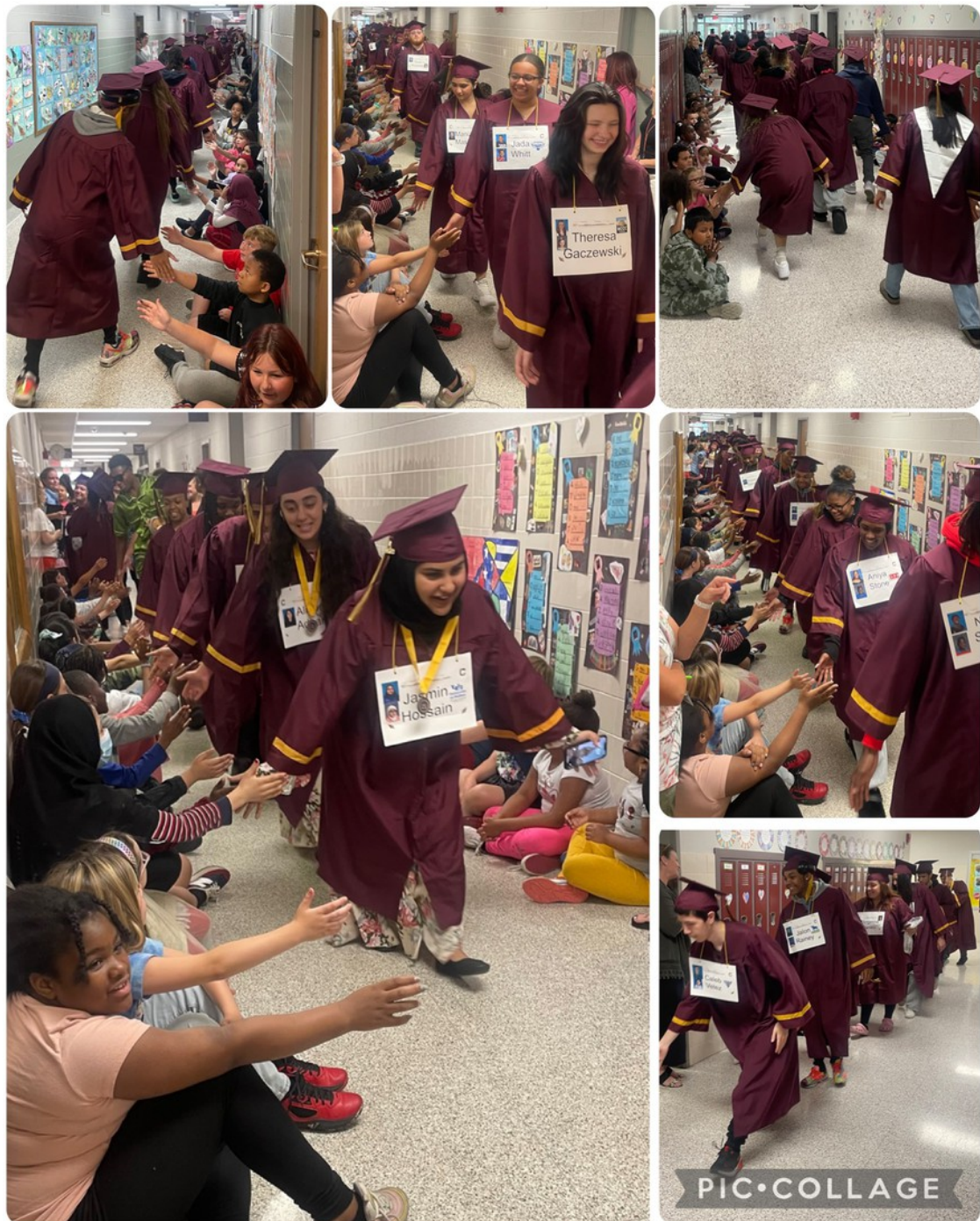

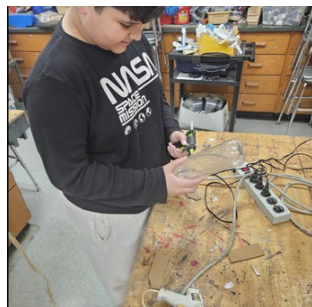


Year Long Gallery Walk...

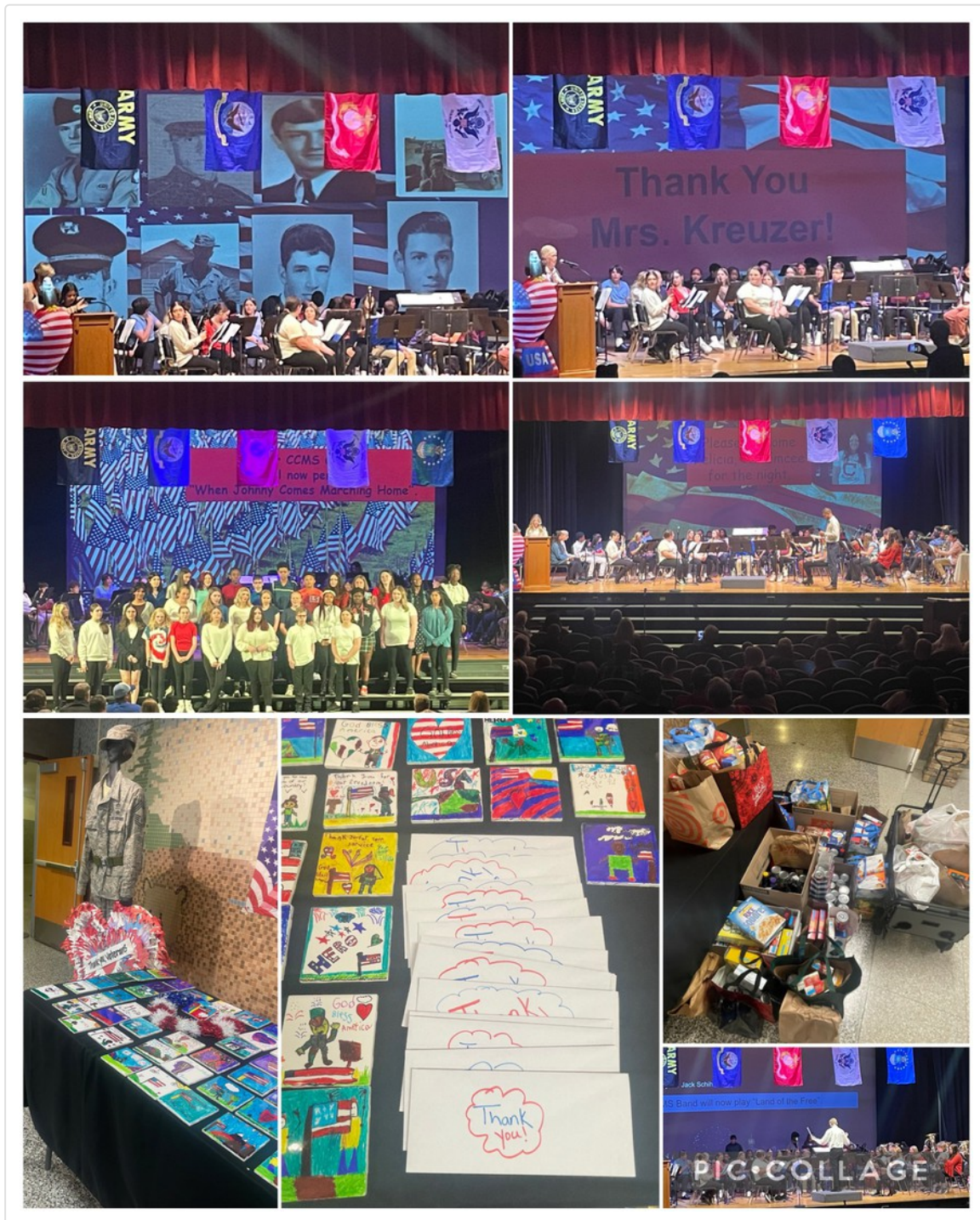

Can a third grader persuade Mr. Zipp???

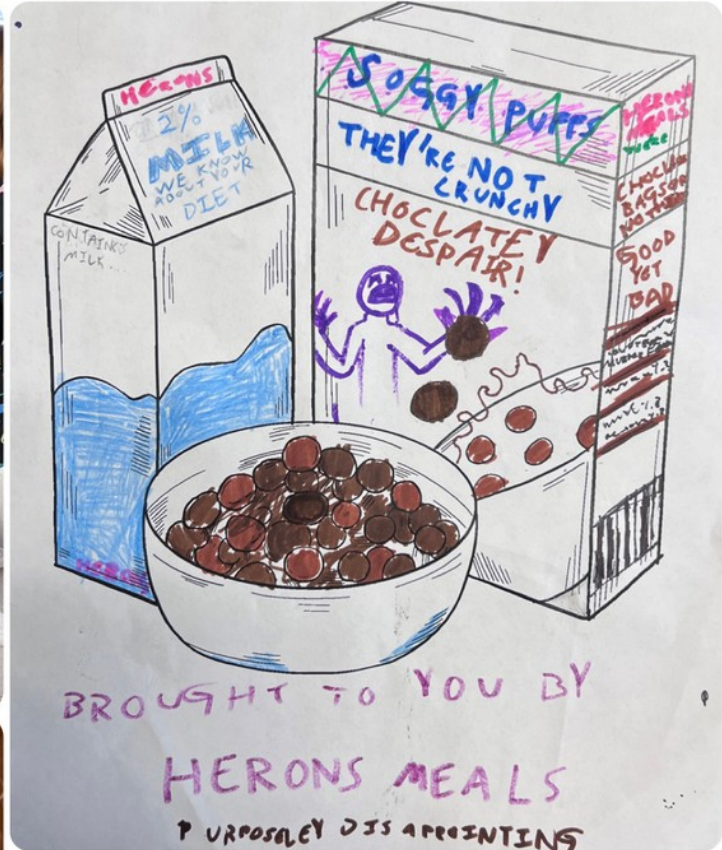
