## Challenge Accepted...

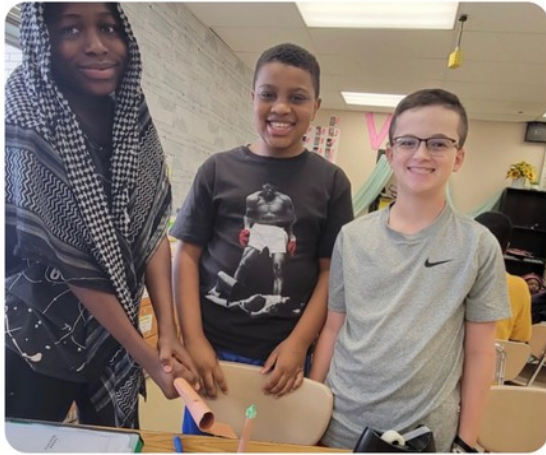
Girls in Mr. Haberl's and Miss Barbati's 5th grade P.E. class challenged Mr. Dolan to a basketball game.

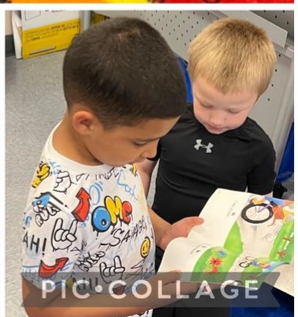

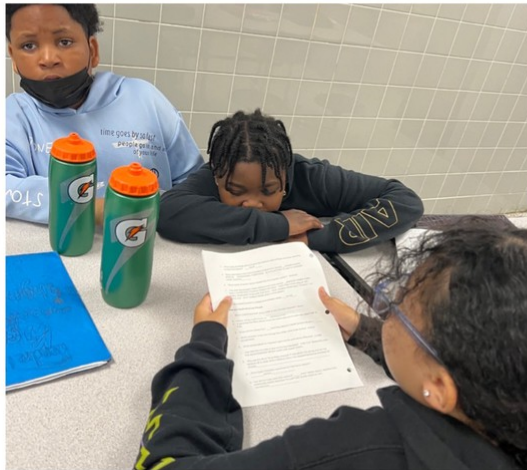
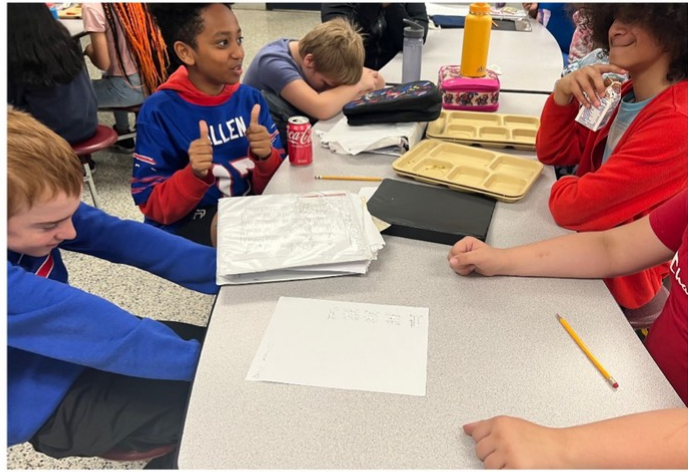
