National Junior Honor Society Induction Ceremony....Congratulations to all the inductees!




5th Grade Life Book Sharing

Dr. Toni Torchia from the Alberti Center for Bullying Abuse Prevention presented to all Middle School students





The next Parent Presentation will take place on April 19th at 6pm of "Social Media Safety"




