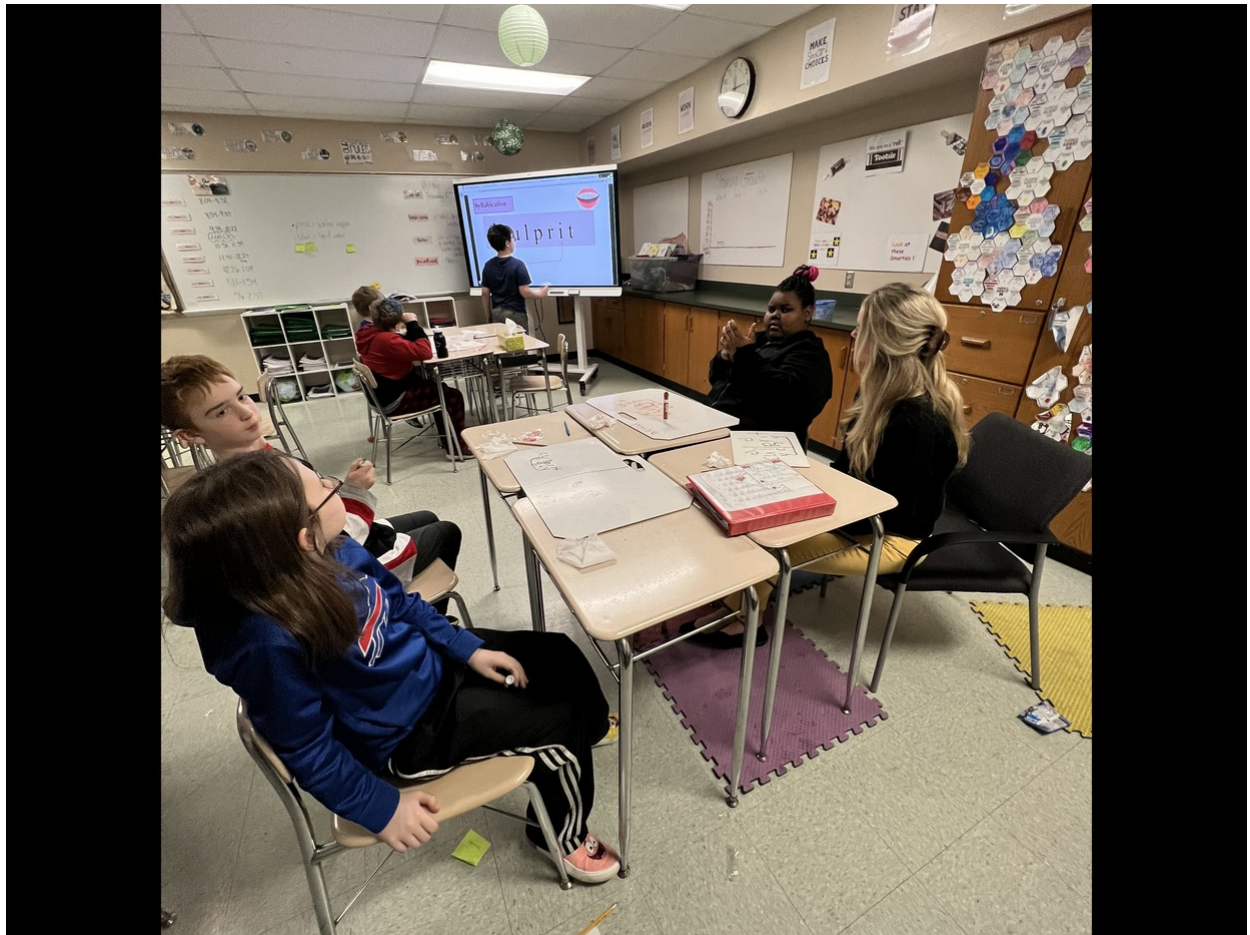
The Vietnam Veterans Food Pantry in Tonawanda feeds over 60 local veterans and offers services to them.

Students will be using this program through their high school years as they refine their career choices.

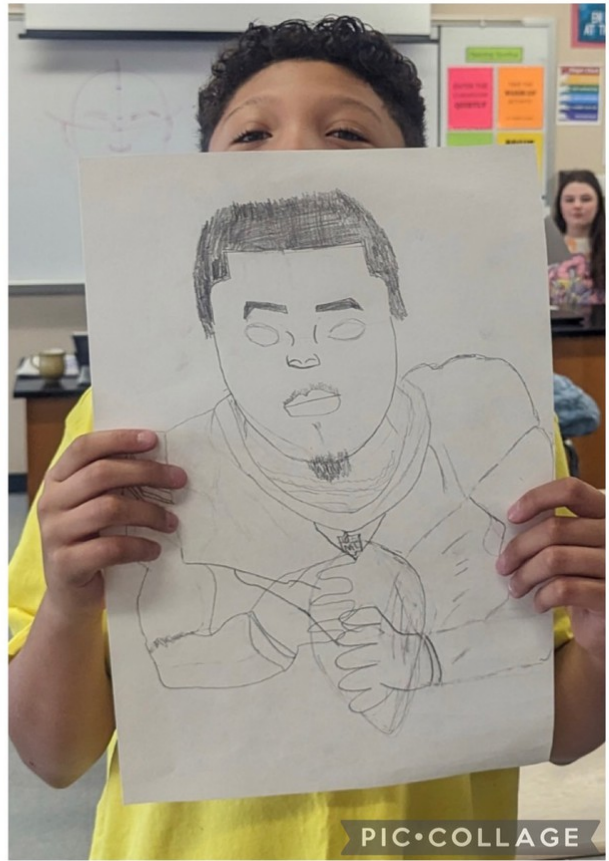

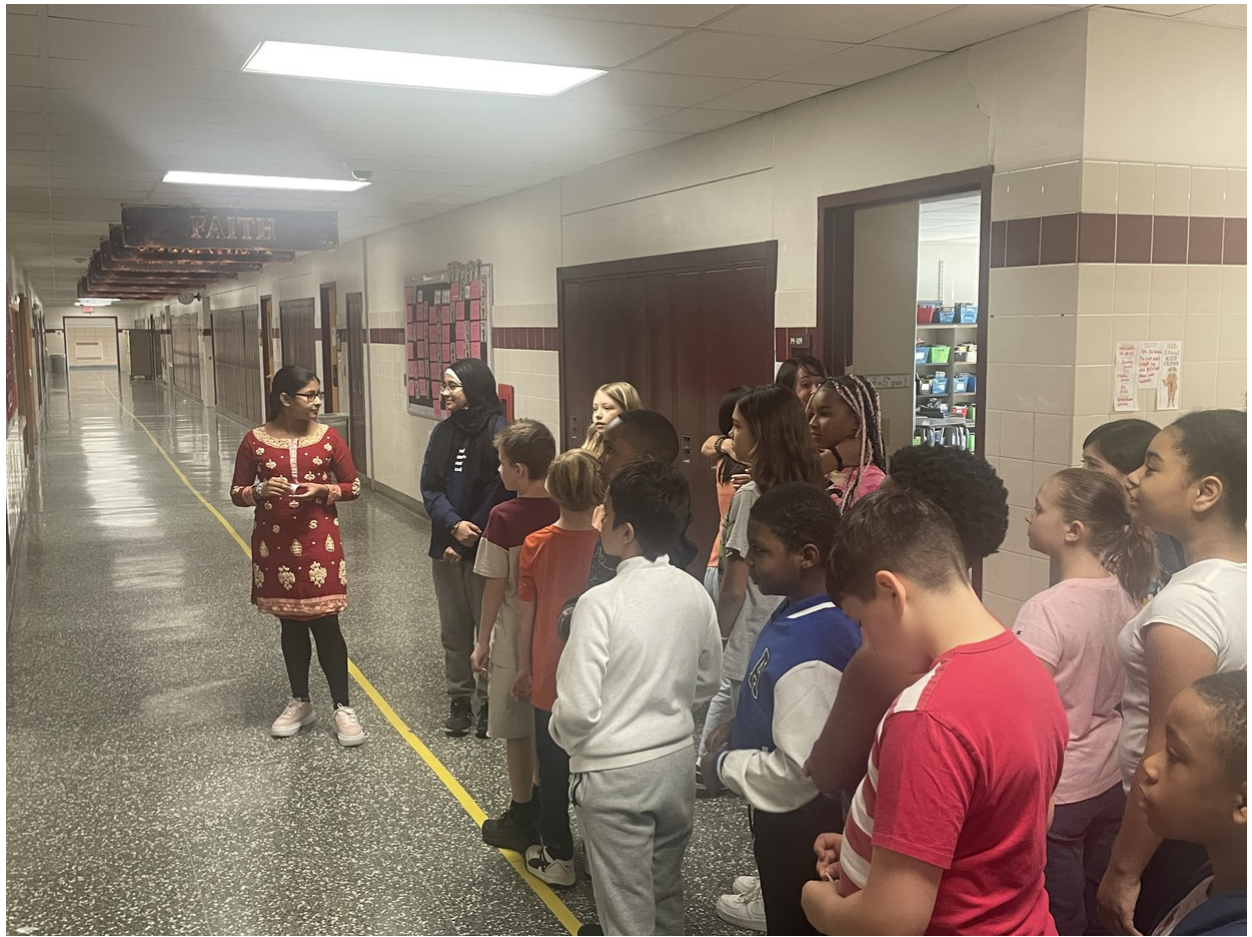


20th Century Selfie...

Thank you to our students, staff, PTA, and all who helped to make this an incredible, fun, team building event!

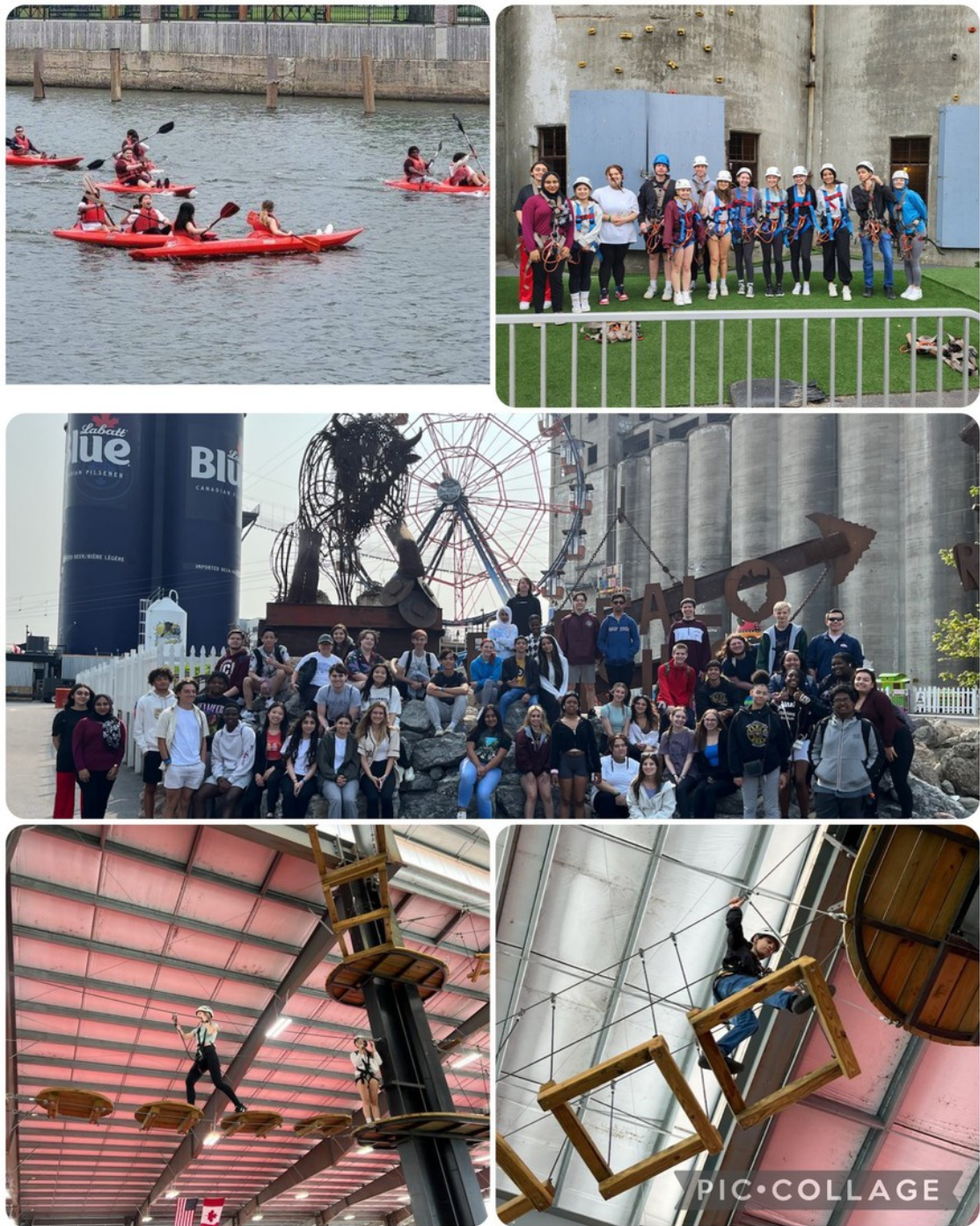


Senior Send Along...
