Remote Learning Plan Overview
2020-2021



The Cheektowaga Central School District has designed a Remote Learning Program to help our families understand the way Remote Learning works, the technology support for Remote Learning and guidelines for our students and parents.

The Cheektowaga Central School District, grades UPK-12, will use the following primary means of communicating assignments, lessons, and activities with students:

- **School Email** - All students (grades 2-12) have a school email account. Students or staff, for school related matters, cannot use personal email accounts.
- **Google Classroom & SeeSaw** - Google Classroom (grades 2-12) and SeeSaw (grades UPK-1) are the primary learning management system for remote learning. These platforms have the ability for teachers to post assignments and instructional materials as well as receive assignments back from students.
- **Google Meet** - Google Meet is a video conferencing platform that allows teachers and students to have real time together. Live video sessions can accommodate up to 250 participants. Students will use their CCSD email address to participate.

Teachers and related service providers will regularly communicate by posting assignments in a Google Classroom or SeeSaw. In addition, teachers may provide live video lessons using Google Meet when needed.

What should students and parents do to ensure success?

- All students, Gr. K-12, will be assigned a device that should be brought home daily. Students in Kindergarten and Grades 1 will be assigned an iPad and students in Grades 2-12 will be assigned a Chromebook.
- Students should ensure their device is charged PRIOR to attending class.
- Make sure you have log on information for your school email, Google Classroom, and any other learning platforms.
- Log into the system daily. If you cannot, contact our faculty & staff using the contact information below.
- Establish and communicate routines and expectations for each day.
- If possible, define a specific physical space for as your child(ren) work space.
- Monitor communications from your child(ren)'s teachers.
- Collaborate with and support your CCSD peers.
- Comply with the Technology Acceptable Use Policy, including expectations for online etiquette.
- Seek out and communicate with other adults at CCSD as needs arise.
- Monitor your child's stress or worry. Communicate with your child's teacher or Student Support Staff (social workers, counselors, etc).
- Ensure that you and your child are engaging in physical activities, mindfulness techniques and other enjoyable, de-stressing activities.

Grading & Attendance

Attendance will be taken during hybrid and remote learning. Grading students during remote learning will remain consistent with the in person grading guidelines. Further details regarding attendance and grading can be found in the building specific Reopening Plans.
